Osmington Bay - Residential Trip - Year 5 Wednesday 11th October to Friday 13th October 2017

Following the success of last year's visit, the school wish to invite all Year 5 pupils to join the residential visit to Osmington Bay, Dorset that has been arranged between Wednesday 11th October and Friday 13th October 2017 inclusive.

The aim of this activity is to help pupils settle into their new classes and year group by living together and working with their peers in a variety of team building activities. Activities range from abseiling, giant swing and trapeze to problem solving and team games. All activities are led and supervised by qualified instructors. Previous experience has shown that participation in such activities help pupils develop their self-confidence, social skills and team building.

The full cost of the visit including transport, all activities, insurance, accommodation and food will be £205. A non-refundable deposit of £30 will be required by Monday 3^{rd} July 2017. A payment card will then be issued and given to your child at the start of the Autumn term. This card must accompany all subsequent payments.

A further instalment of £50 will be required by Friday 8th September and full payment by Friday, 29th September 2017. After the first two payments have been made, and to help spread the cost of the trip, instalments of any amount can be paid as long as the final payment is made by the final due date.

Eligible families may apply to The Ilminster Educational Foundation for a grant towards this trip. An application form can be collected from Messrs Mitcham & Co., Cornhill, Ilminster.

The trip organiser reserves the right to ask parents/guardians to remove their child from the venue for reasons of misconduct.
