

Appendix F – Register of Declared Interests

Since September 2015 Governing Bodies have been required to publish, on the school’s website, a Governors’ register of interests. Governors are asked to declare any interests at the time of their appointment and, on an annual basis, to sign the register confirming that the records held are complete and accurate.

Governors should declare:

1. Any relevant business and pecuniary interests where the person concerned, their family (immediate family and other relatives) or close friends have a connection with a potential supplier, or where there is any other business connection (as employer, employee or major shareholder);
2. Governance roles in other educational institutions;

Any material interests arising from relationships between governors, or relationships between governors and school staff (including spouses, partners and close relatives, where the **person concerned could be advantaged or disadvantaged by a decision of the governing body.**
