### **GREAT WOOD CAMP - 20<sup>th</sup> May – 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

The school wishes to invite Year 7 pupils to join an exciting residential trip to Great Wood camp in the Quantock Hills from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May - Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May.

The aim of this trip is to give the pupils a valuable residential experience in the company of their peers and to participate in outdoor activities such as; orienteering, archery, stream/map work, forest shelter building, swimming and the 'one match challenge'. One of the residential days is spent at Kilve Court – again a selection of activities such as; a stream walk, mountain boarding, high ropes, archery and grass sledging.

Throughout the visit, all activities are led and/or supervised by qualified instructors and/or members of Swanmead staff. The programme of activities may vary slightly subject to prevailing weather conditions and opportunities/local situations applicable at the time.

The full cost of the visit including transport, accommodation, food and **all activities** will approximately be £230 – (the amount may vary by £5 either way and is TBC with the centre)

Payment Plan;

- £60 non – refundable deposit payable no later than **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019**
- A further instalment of £70 payable by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019**
- Final balance of £100 to be paid no later than **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019**

To make payment for this visit easier, payments can be made in instalments of any size (including the deposit) and a payment card will be issued to assist with keeping track of this.



Eligible families may apply to The Ilminster Education Foundation for a grant towards the trip. An application form can be collected from Mitcham and Co. Accountants, Cornhill, Ilminster. In addition, children who are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding (Free school meals, children looked after, children of armed forces personnel etc.) will be financed for £100 of this trip. Please contact Mrs Spurway in the Finance Office if you wish to take advantage of this proportion of the experience being paid.

The acceptance of the deposit does not guarantee your child's place on the trip. If the trip is over-subscribed, a first come first served basis will apply with a reserve list being created (deposits will be returned if your child does not get a place on the trip). Conversely, in the event of insufficient take up or insufficient funding, the school will be unable to proceed with the trip.

As is the case for all our residentials, a pupil whose behaviour is of concern in school and therefore raises issues for the safety of themselves, or that of others, could be withdrawn from the trip. This will be reviewed before the trip takes place and could forego their place. In such a circumstance, any money paid would be returned and the reason for the decision communicated to the parent/guardian and child. It is therefore important for parents to continue to emphasise the importance of excellent behaviour and conduct both in and out of school at all times.


